Bowood House sits in the centre of one of England's finest parklands, created by "Capability" Brown in the 1760's. Since when the gardens and grounds have been continuously evolving.

From Spring, 2010 onwards guided group tours will be available. The tour will start from the imposing terraces in front of the house, skirting lake field overlooking Brown's great lake, down to Hamilton's Cascade and Grotto, round Temple Island, back through the famous arboretum, returning for lunch in the House. The walking tour covers around two miles and takes up to two hours. Seats are positioned along the route. After lunch group members can explore the public rooms in their own time.
